





| Year 2                         | <p><b>CREATION</b></p>  <p><b>‘How do people and stories in the Old Testament inspire us to look after God’s creation?’</b></p> <p>Looks at God as creator and how He works through His people to protect His creation.</p> <p>Explores why the Old Testament is proclaimed as the Word of God.</p> <p>Looks at the Jewish festival of the harvest (Sukkot).</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> Genesis 6: 9 -22<br/> Jonah ch.1 &amp; 2<br/> Genesis 1:3, 9, 20, 24, 26<br/> Psalm 19: 1-6<br/> Luke 12: 27-28<br/> Isaiah 41: 17-18<br/> Psalm 147: 4-5, 8-9, 15-18</p> <p><b>HARVEST CELEBRATION</b></p> | <p><b>PRAYERS SAINTS AND FEASTS</b></p>  <p><b>‘How can the examples of Mary and the saints show us how to respond to the call of Jesus?’</b></p> <p>Extends the knowledge of the life of Mary and Jesus through prayer (the Rosary) and Scripture.</p> <p>Explores the lives of some saints who responded to the call of Jesus.</p> <p>Looks at Islam and the feast of Ramadan.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> John 2:1-12 - Wedding Feast of Cana<br/> Matthew 2:13-15 Journey into Egypt<br/> Mark 2:13-17 Dinner at Levi’s house</p> <p>Any Scripture linked to the individual Mysteries.</p> | <p><b>CHRISTMAS</b></p>  <p><b>‘Which are the key journeys in the Christmas Story?’</b></p> <p>Shows how we can get to know Jesus through the journeys of others.</p> <p>Looks at the journey of the Magi in detail and introduces the Flight to Egypt.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> Luke 1:26-38 The Annunciation<br/> Matthew 1:18-23 The Christmas Story</p> | <p><b>LENT</b></p>  <p><b>‘Why is Lent a time for repentance and forgiveness?’</b></p> <p>Looks at Lent as being preparation for Easter, commencing with Ash Wednesday, and being a time of seeking forgiveness and doing penance.</p> <p>Looks in detail at the ‘Our Father’.</p> <p>Looks at the Torah and the Jewish faith.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> Luke 15: 1 – 7 The Parable of the Lost Sheep<br/> Matthew 18: 21 – 23 Forgive 70 x 7<br/> Matthew 18: 23 – 35 The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant<br/> The Text of the Our Father<br/> Luke 15: 11 – 32 The Parable of the Prodigal Son</p> | <p><b>EASTER</b></p>  <p><b>‘How can we share and use what we learn about Easter to help others?’</b></p> <p>Looks in further detail at the account of the empty tomb.</p> <p>Thomas is introduced, to show that people responded in different ways to the Resurrection of Jesus.</p> <p>The Hindu feast of Holi is studied.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> Luke 24: 1 – 12 (Resurrection Account)<br/> John 20: 1 – 18 (Resurrection Account)<br/> John 20: 24 – 29 (Doubting Thomas)</p> | <p><b>SACRAMENTS</b></p>  <p><b>‘How do promises and symbols help us to better understand the Sacraments?’</b></p> <p>Looks at what a Sacrament is, with a specific focus on the Sacraments of Baptism, Marriage, and the Eucharist.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> None specified, but references to The Baptism of Jesus and The Last Supper would be appropriate.</p> |

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|  |  | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>ADVENT</u></b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><b>‘How can we help prepare the way for the Lord?’</b></p> <p>Looks at the symbolism to help us to get ready to meet Jesus.</p> <p>Looks at the main themes/symbols linked to Advent.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> <i>Isaiah 7:14</i><br/> <i>Luke 1:8-23</i><br/> <i>Luke 3: 1-17</i><br/> <i>Matthew 3:1-12</i><br/> <i>Isaiah 9</i></p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>REVELATION</u></b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><b>‘How do the example and teachings of Jesus show us what we should do as one of his followers?’</b></p> <p>Explores stories from the Scripture which show how special Jesus is, looking in particular at the miracle stories.</p> <p>Looks at the three duties of a Sikh.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b></p> <p><b>From earlier year groups:</b><br/> <i>John 2: 1 – 12 The Wedding Feast at Cana</i><br/> <i>Luke 15: 11 – 32 The Parable of the Prodigal Son</i></p> <p><i>Mark 4: 35 – 41 The Calming of the Storm</i><br/> <i>Luke 7: 1 -10 The Healing of the Centurion’s Daughter</i><br/> <i>Mark 4: 1-9 The Parable of the Sower</i><br/> <i>Matthew 25: 14 – 30 The Parable of the Talents</i></p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>HOLY WEEK</u></b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><b>‘What messages from Holy Week can guide us today?’</b></p> <p>Looks at the Crucifixion of Jesus and considers the events of Holy week through the eyes of Mary.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> <i>Matthew 27: 32 – 50</i><br/> <i>John 13: 1 – 15</i><br/> <i>John 15 : 12</i></p> | <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>PENTECOST AND MISSION</u></b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;"><b>‘What promise did Jesus keep at Pentecost?’</b></p> <p>Examines the nature of the promise made by Jesus to send his Spirit.</p> <p>Identifies Pentecost as the birthday of the Church.</p> <p>Examines the link between Pentecost and Confirmation.</p> <p><b>Scripture:</b><br/> <i>Genesis 9: 8 – 17 The promise God made to Noah</i><br/> <i>Acts 2:1 – 10 The Coming of the Spirit</i><br/> <i>John 16: 7 – 15 The promise of the Spirit</i><br/> <i>Matthew 1: 20 – 23 The promise of the Birth of Jesus</i></p> |  |
