Explores the lives of some saints who responded to the call of Jesus. Looks at Islam and the feast of Ramadan. Scripture: John 2:1-12 - Wedding Feast of Cana Matthew 2:13-15 Journey into Egypt Mark 2:13-17 Dinner at Levi's house Any Scripture linked to the individual Mysteries.	'Which are the key journeys in the Christmas Story?' Shows how we can get to know Jesus through the journeys of others. Looks at the journey of the Magi in detail and introduces the Flight to Egypt. Scripture: Luke 1:26-38 The Annunciation Matthew 1:18-23 The Christmas Story	Looks at Lent as being preparation for Easter, commencing with Ash Wednesday, and being a time of seeking forgiveness and doing penance. Looks at the symbolism to help us to get ready to meet Jesus.

Looks at the main themes/symbols linked to Advent.
