Dear Families of Holy Cross,

Welcome back to 2022! What a fantastic start to the new term! Thank you to those families who have chosen to email in sharing their positive feedback on changes they have seen in the school. As you are aware Holy Cross Primary is on a rapid improvement journey and it is key that we focus our energies on great teaching and learning in every classroom, everyday, for every child. We will continue to be supported and monitored by the Local Authority and Diocese and I will of course share these updates as they arise.

On this note, we know that it is important to support all children in their learning so we will be supplying all the children with the equipment they need in their classroom. This includes pens, pencils, rulers and colouring pencils. The Y2 children have already loved using their new special school pencils- producing some great handwriting! Therefore children will be bringing home their pencil cases, if they have brought them in to school, except Y6 who can choose to bring in their own, if they wish, getting them ready for independence at Secondary school.

In addition, we would ask that children now come in to school in their full Holy Cross PE kit (including black or blue tracksuit bottoms to keep them warm) on their dedicated PE day which is detailed in this newsletter. The children will be having specialist PE and Sports development with our new, very experienced, Sports Coach Mr McCormack. Mr McCormack will also be taking on responsibility for the Team Sports and Fixtures at Holy Cross. It is really important that all the children look just as smart in their PE uniform as they do in their normal daily uniform so I ask that you check the requirements and by half term every child has the correct PE uniform requirements. This really does create a sense of pride and team spirit in the children!

She told me all about her idea to support children and celebrate their kindness. She spent time designing the certificate and spoke to the children about what they can do to receive the award. Amen


## School Development News:
