





<p>Year 5</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CREATION</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘How should we live as one of the People of God?’</p> <p>Explores how we become creators, which involves the two creation stories in Genesis.</p> <p>What it means to be the People of God, as expressed by St Paul and as expressed in the Beatitudes.</p> <p>Looks at the importance of peace through the five pillars of Islam.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Genesis 1:1 – 2:4 (Creation – first account)</i> <i>Genesis 2:5 – 23 (Creation – second account)</i> <i>Colossians 3:12-17 (People of God)</i> <i>Mt 5: 1 – 12 (Sermon on the Mount: Beatitudes)</i></p> <p>Additional Scripture <i>Genesis 22 1-18 (Abraham tested)</i> <i>Psalm 104 (God the Creator)</i> <i>Leviticus 19:9-10 (Do not over reap)</i> <i>Luke 12:32-34 (Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also)</i> <i>Isaiah 1:17 Learn to do right; seek justice)</i> <i>Micah 6:8 (to do justly, and to love mercy, and to humble thyself, to walk with thy God.)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PRAYERS SAINTS AND FEASTS</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘How do the Saints guide us in carrying out the work of Jesus today?’</p> <p>Examines how the work of Jesus is continued through us as illustrated in the prayer of St Teresa of Avila.</p> <p>Examines the concept of pilgrimage as a journey of prayer.</p> <p>Looks at the importance of the pilgrimage to Mecca for Muslims.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Luke 18:35-43 - Healing of the blind man</i> <i>James 5:13-16</i> <i>Mark 10:46-52 – Healing of Bartimaeus</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">CHRISTMAS</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘How can the circumstances of Jesus’ birth inspire our actions today?’</p> <p>Explores the difficulties faced by Mary and Joseph as revealed in Matthew’s Gospel, including the role of King Herod.</p> <p>Examines the implications of the Christmas story for us today.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Matthew 1: 18 – 2: 23</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">LENT</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘Why is change a key theme for Lent?’</p> <p>Looks at the concept of temptation.</p> <p>Looks at how preparation for Easter involves becoming more like Jesus through St. Paul’s teaching.</p> <p>Explores Jewish understanding of repentance.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Matthew 4: 1 – 11</i> <i>Mark 1: 12 – 13</i> <i>Luke 4: 1 – 13</i> <i>1 Corinthians 13: 4 – 13</i> <i>Colossians 3: 12 – 15</i> <i>Ephesians 4: 1 – 13</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">EASTER</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘How can the Easter Triduum guide and inspire us?’</p> <p>Examines the Church’s belief in eternal life, as shown in the Easter story.</p> <p>Explores the story of Lazarus.</p> <p>Looks at symbolism in Hinduism.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Easter Vigil Service</i> <i>John 11: 17 – 44 Lazarus</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">SACRAMENTS</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">‘Why are Holy Orders and Matrimony Sacraments of service/vocation?’</p> <p>Looks at the commitment expressed in the Sacraments of Holy Orders and Matrimony.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Tobit 8: 5 – 7 The Wedding Prayer of Tobias and Sarah</i> <i>Matthew 19: 4 – 6</i> <i>1 Corinthians 13: 4 – 7</i> <i>Ruth 1: 16 – 17</i></p>

	HARVEST CELEBRATION	<p style="text-align: center;">ADVENT</p>  <p>Connects the coming of Jesus with the promise revealed in the Old Testament and looks at the titles that were given to the expected Messiah in the Old Testament.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Micah 5:2</i> <i>Jeremiah 23:5-6</i> <i>Ezekiel 34:23-24</i> <i>Lk 1:5-25 & 57- 80</i> <i>Mk 1:1-8</i> <i>Lk 3:1-18</i></p> <p>Additional Scripture <i>Other scripture that tells us to repent, forgive and change:</i> <i>Matthew 18:21 (How many times should I forgive?)</i> <i>Luke 19:1 – 10 (Zacchaeus)</i> <i>Matthew 18:21 – 35 (The Unforgiving Servant)</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">REVELATION</p>  <p>'How does getting to know Jesus help us to know God better?' Study of certain parables looks at our understanding of the Kingdom of God and explores how the divine revelation is communicated, particularly in baptism.</p> <p>Explores stories told by Guru Nanak and other gurus.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Matthew 3:13-17</i> <i>Mark 1:9-11</i> <i>Luke 3:21-22</i> <i>John 1:29-34</i> <i>Matthew 3:1-12</i> <i>Mark 4:1-9, 13-20</i> <i>Luke 8:4-15 Parable of the Sower</i> <i>Matthew 7:24-27</i> <i>Luke 6:46-49 Parable of House Built on Sand</i> <i>Matthew 22:1-14</i> <i>Luke 14:15-24 - Parable of King's Wedding Feast</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">HOLY WEEK</p>  <p>'How does the story of Jesus driving the traders from the temple help us understand the tensions around Jesus?' Provides a focus on Jesus driving the traders from the temple.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Holy Week passages</i> <i>Luke 19: 28 – 40</i> <i>Matthew 21: 12 – 13</i> <i>John 12: 12 – 19</i> <i>John 13: 1 – 19</i> <i>Mark 14: 12 – 26</i> <i>Exodus chapters 12 and 13</i></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">PENTECOST AND MISSION</p>  <p>'In what ways does the Holy Spirit transform lives?' Explores the Church's belief in the Holy Spirit within the Trinity.</p> <p>Looks at the role of the apostles proclaiming the Good News.</p> <p>Scripture: <i>Acts 2:1-13 & 38-47 (The Holy Spirit comes at Pentecost)</i> <i>Acts 2: 14-21 (Peter's message to the crowd)</i> <i>2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (Being a follower of Jesus and making friendships)</i> <i>John 14:16-17 (The Holy Trinity)</i></p> <p>Additional Scripture: <i>1 Corinthians 6:19 (The Gift of the Holy Spirit living in you)</i> <i>Romans 8:16 (God's Spirit joins himself to our spirits - we are God's children.)</i> <i>2 Timothy 3:16 (The use of scripture)</i> <i>Colossians 3:16 (Welcoming everyone by sharing the message of God through praise and through the Spirit)</i> <i>1 Corinthians 12:27-31 (Your role within God's Church – being part of the body of Christ)</i> <i>Colossians 3:12-17 (Clothe yourselves in the gifts from the Holy Spirit)</i></p>
