Dear Families of Holy Cross,

This week I have been chatting to the staff about how we can support our family and school partnership as I know it has been a long time since many of you have been into the school building or looked at your child's books.

Therefore I am pleased to say I have a date for your diary!

On **Monday 31st January** we will be opening up the school for an 'informal meet and greet' between **3:15-4:00pm**.

You are most welcome to come into the school (anytime between this time) with your child and go directly to your child's classroom, look at their books and meet their class teacher. This is an informal session which celebrates our children but also provides you the opportunity to feel more at ease with who is who and what your child gets up to in their day at Holy Cross!

In order to make this happen we have had to review our risk assessment for COVID 19 and ask that you kindly follow the protocols below in respect of one another and our dedicated staffing team:

- If you have any symptoms you do not enter the site. We will look for another opportunity for you on a different date.
- You wear a face mask at all times in the building unless wearing a medical exemption lanyard.
- You continue to social distance from families outside your household bubble and maintain space if the classroom is busy.
- You consider taking an LFT test that afternoon before coming to the school (this is not compulsory but would be advisable)

The staffing team will be wearing masks, windows and doors will be open for ventilation and they will also socially distance but are there for you to chat to so do please say 'Hello!'

We really want this event to happen for you and the children as we know this is important but we also want to keep our community safe and our school open for the children so thank you for understanding and following these protocols. Fingers crossed we can't wait to see you!
