STRATEGY STATEMENT

At Holy Cross Catholic Primary School, we have identified that the disruption caused by Covid-19 has impacted our pupils learning in a number of ways. Through our benchmarking and assessment procedures, we have identified specific need in Maths, Phonics, Reading, Writing and in some cases a drop in resilience to work. A significant amount of our Covid-19 Catch up funding has been spent on the employment of 2 Learning Support Assistants. This will enable us to provide additional learning support to all classes to narrow the gaps in their learning and support with Social and Emotional Wellbeing.

The aim of this strategy is:

- Focused support with Literacy, Phonics and Reading.

 Pupils work in small groups and on a 1-1 basis with staff member to fill the gaps in their learning bringing them back in line with where they should be.
- Focused support in Maths.

 Pupils work in small groups and on a 1-1 basis with staff member to fill identified gaps in their learning to bring them in line with where they should be.
- Focused small group work with pupils to explore barriers to learning and develop resilience to learning.

Planned Expenditure for Academic Year – 2020-2021

LSA x 2 fixed term until July 2021 - £12.168

The remaining amount from the Covid-19 Catch up grant will be spent on resources for pupils in school, identified throughout the academic year. Such items will be identified as supportive measures to close the gaps in pupils learning and improve pupil attainment.
