EYFS	'How can we find out about God's Creation and give Him thanks?' Introduces God as creator of all and our response to the world He created. Explores ways of talking to God through prayer. Explains and introduces the Sign of the Cross. Scripture: Children's version of the Creation story. Isaiah 43: 1-3 Genesis 1: 3, 9, 20, 24-26 HARVEST CELEBRATION	'How do others show they love and care for us, how can we show we care about them?' Explores how the family help us get to know God through prayer. Explores the role of Mary in the life of Jesus. Introduces the Muslim faith and the importance of prayer. Scripture: John 2:1-11 - The wedding feast of Cana Luke 2:41-52 - The finding of Jesus in the temple John 14:2-4 - My Father's house has many rooms. Luke 12:6-7 Matthew 6: 9-13 - Jesus teaches us how to pray Matthew 4: 18 - 22 - calling of disciples Mark 1: 16 - 20 - calling of disciples Luke 5: 1 - 11 - calling of disciples	'What happened at the first Christmas?' Explores the story of the first Christmas. Scripture: Matthew 1:18-25 The Birth of Jesus Luke 2:1-20 The Birth of Jesus – Shepherds Luke 1:26-38 – The Annunciation	'How can we help others in Lent?' Introduces Lent as a time when we get ready for Easter and introduces, through the example and teaching of Jesus, different ways of getting ready. Looks at how Jesus followed the Jewish faith and how Jewish people go to a synagogue to pray. Scripture: Matthew 25: 14 – 30 – The parable of the talents Mark 10: 46 – 52 – The healing of the blind man	'Why is Easter a time of joy and hope?' Looks at the joy of Easter by reflecting on the emotions of those discovering the empty tomb. Introduces the Hindu faith. Scripture: The Easter Story from a children's Bible.	'How is God with us as we grow?' Introduces the idea of God's presence at all times in our lives. Uses language of sacraments. Scripture: Child-friendly accounts of: Presentation of Jesus (Baptism) Zacchaeus (Reconciliation) Feeding of 5000 (Eucharist) Pentecost (Confirmation) Wedding Feast of Cana (Matrimony) Calling of Disciples (Holy Orders) Cure of the Blind Man (Sacrament of the Sick)

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ADVENT



'How should we get ready for Christmas?'

Introduces Advent as a special time when we get ready for the birth of Jesus.

Scripture:

The Annunciation (child-friendly version)

REVELATION



'How can we be like Jesus and be a shepherd to others?'

Looks at how God is shown in our lives and through the work of others, including the priest.

Introduces the Sikh faith.

Scripture:

Matthew 14: 13-21 – Feeding of the five thousand Mark 10:3-16 – Jesus and the children Luke 15:3-7 – Parable of the Lost Sheep John 10:11-18 – Good Shepherd

HOLY WEEK



'What happened during Holy Week?'

Explores the events which led up to Easter.

Scripture:

Child-friendly accounts of the events of Holy Week.

PENTECOST AND MISSION



'What should the friends of Jesus do?

Looks at the events in the upper room and explores what a friend of Jesus does.

Scripture:

Acts 2: 1-13 The Coming of the Holy Spirit.

Deuteronomy: 16:9-11 (Pentecost as a harvest festival)

Luke 24:46-49 (The Promise from God and being witnesses of God)
